

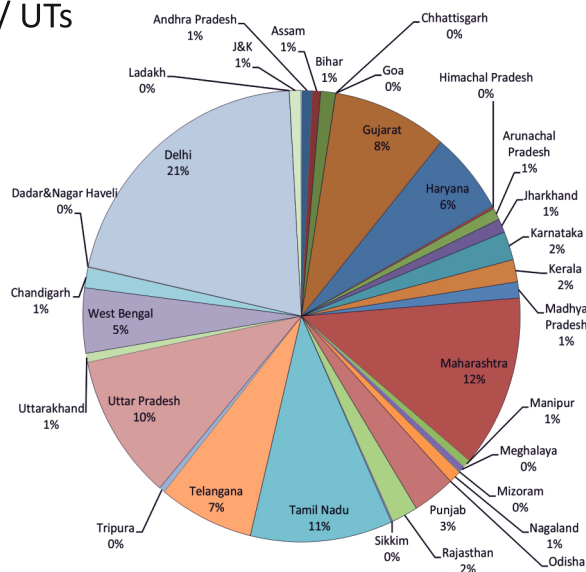


Result of Survey on Awareness level of Management and Teaching Staff of Schools on Children's Safety and Well-being as of 10th November 2023

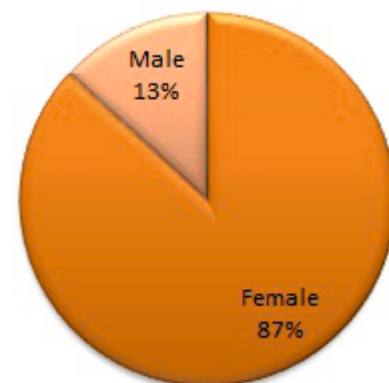

The survey contains 17 close-ended questions. Participants must select any one of the options in the check box for each question.

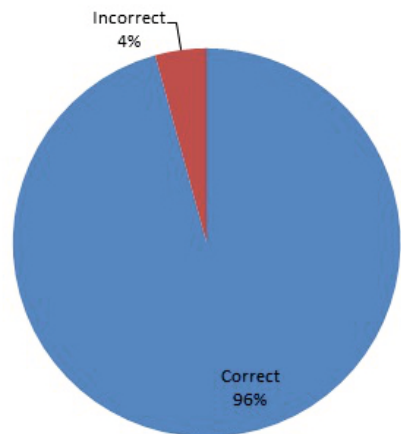
1. A child as per UNCRC/POCSO Act/JJ Act is any person below the age of?

Answer: 18 Years



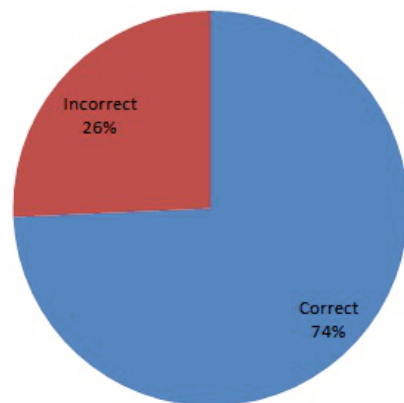
2. According to the Ministry of Women and Child Development (MW&CD) - Govt. of India survey (2007), what percentage of children go through Child Sexual Abuse?

Answer: About 50%



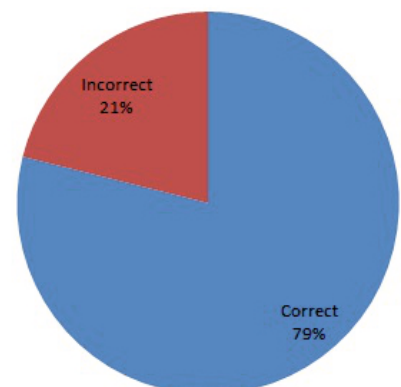
3. According to the same survey, what percentage of children keep quiet about sexual abuse?

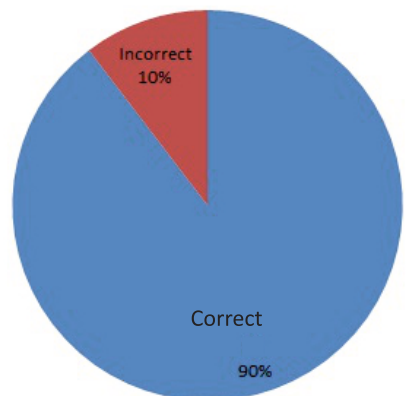

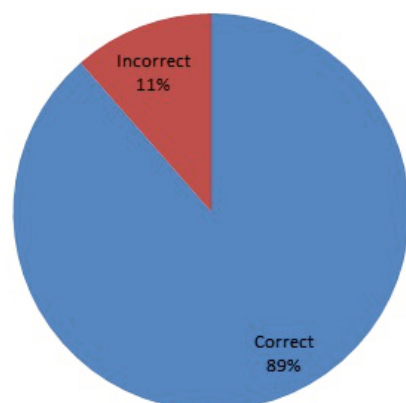

8. Who is the boss of the child's body?

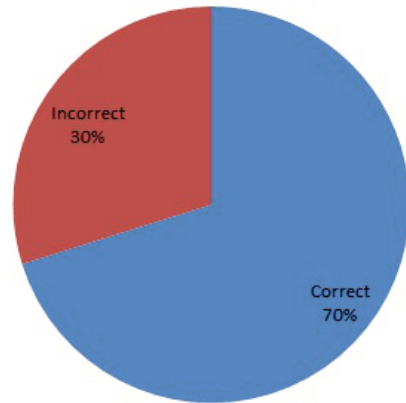

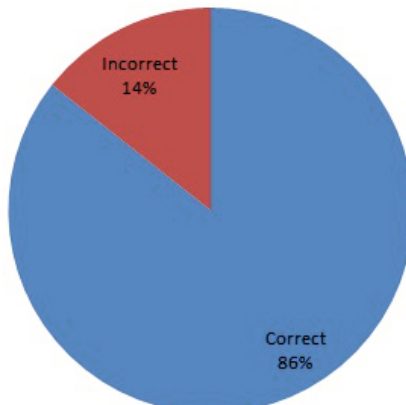

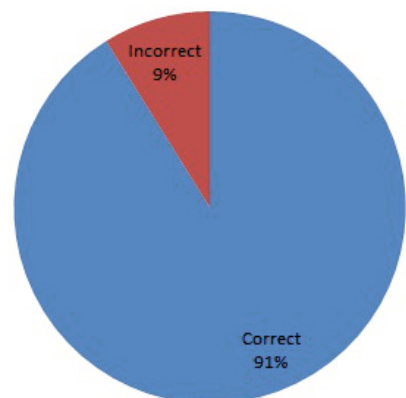

Answer: Juvenile Justice Board



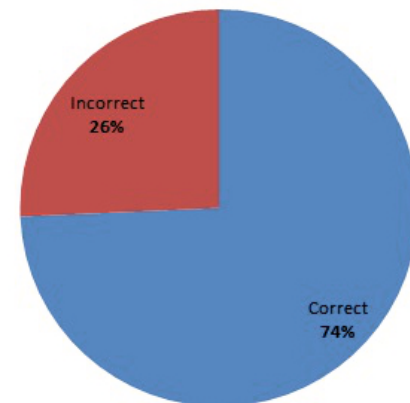

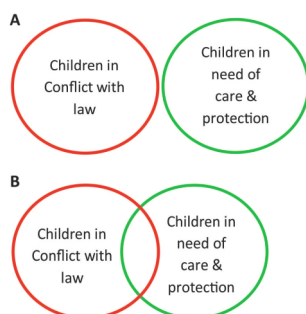

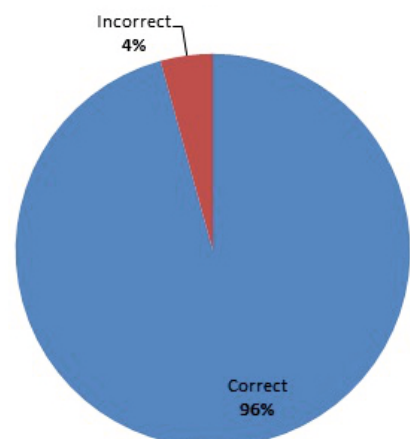
