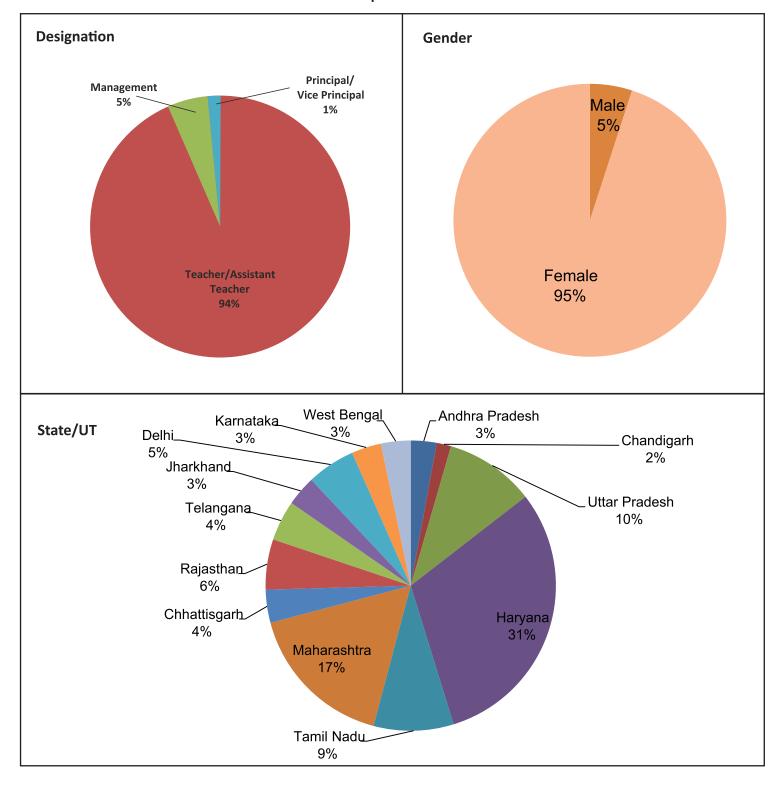

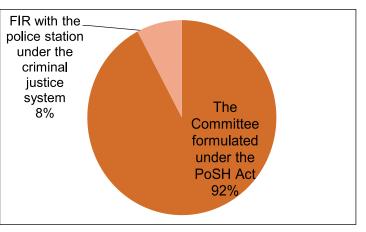




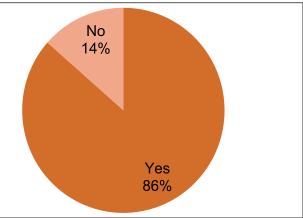
Survey Description

The survey contains 10 close-ended questions. Participants must select any one of the options in the check box for each question. There are no right or wrong answers.

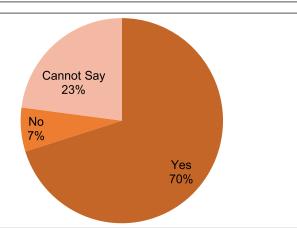
1. Where do you think a woman facing sexual harassment in the workplace will be more open and comfortable in filing a complaint?



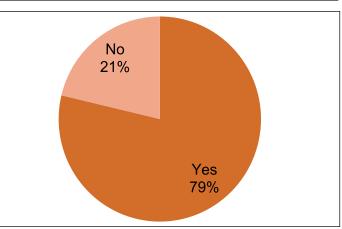
2. Do you think that the PoSH Act should also include male victims?



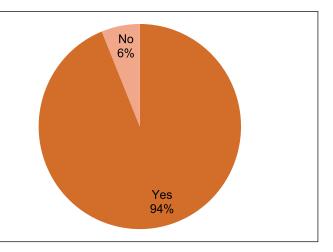
3. In your opinion, should the PoSH Act be applied in retrospect?



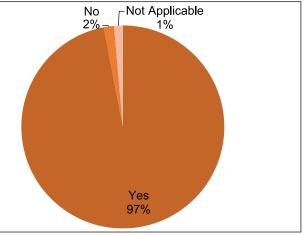
4. Do you agree that a woman has a higher overall risk than a man of being sexually exploited?



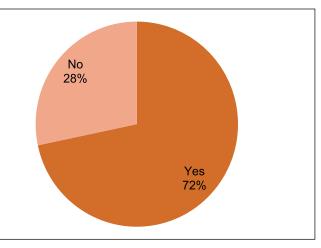
5. Do you think that because of the PoSH Act, some male employers or employees may feel nervous about women in the workforce, thus hampering the employment opportunities of women?



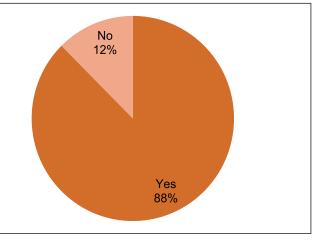
6. Should an organisation's leave policy consider provision for leaves for women for their menstruation days?



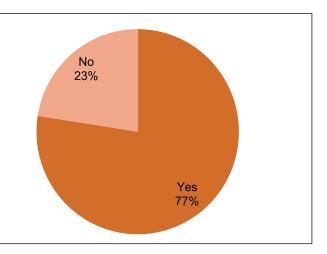
7. Which of the following did you already know about? Tick the Box(es)
